### (Cumberland Falls Moonbow)

**Day 1** – Imagine a wall of water falling 60 feet into a boulder-strewn gorge, a whispering mist that kisses the face and creates a “**magical moonbow**”, visible on a clear night under a full moon. **Cumberland Falls State Park** is such a place and this is where we will stay for the next two nights at **DuPont Lodge**.

**Day 2** – This morning we travel to Stearns, Kentucky, to board the **Big South Fork Scenic Railway**. Take a ride on the **Kentucky and Tennessee Railway** on a sixteen mile round trip into the **Daniel Boone National Forest** and **Big South Fork National River and Recreation Area**. This trip is full of spectacular scenic vistas, lush vegetation, and mountain streams as it descends 600 ft. into the gorge before stopping at **Blue Heron coal Mining Camp**, a National Park Service outdoor interpretive site. You will have a **coal miner's lunch** served picnic style and wrapped in a **souvenir bandana**. There will also be time to visit the **McCreary County Museum in Stearns**. **(B L)**

**Day 3** – After an included breakfast, we will make our way to **Berea, Kentucky**, shopping and lunch on our own in this unique college town. Here students from the Appalachian Mountain Area are given the opportunity to work their way through college. This evening we will have a fun time as we enjoy dinner and show at **Renfro Valley**, where we spend the night. **(B D)**

**Day 4-** Enjoy an included breakfast this morning before we tour the popular **Kentucky Country Music Hall of Fame**. Depart later in the morning for a seafood lunch at **Jim's on the River** in Frankfort, Kentucky. From here, we leave for home with lots of fond memories of our trip. **(B L)**
