Day 1 – Colorful fall scenery, entertainment, good food and fun with new friends await us as we begin our journey toward the Smoky Mountains. Lunch is on your own today. This evening we will have a fun time as we enjoy dinner and a show at **Renfro Valley. (D)**

Day 2 – Breakfast is included this morning, and then we work our way toward Cherokee, NC. Day 4 – After an included breakfast at the hotel, the morning is free to explore Pigeon Forge or Gatlinburg and have lunch on your own before we experience the **Titanic**, the world’s largest museum attraction. The museum is built half-scale to the original Titanic. Towering 100 feet above the parkway, it holds 400 priceless artifacts in 20 galleries.
